Fleurieu, South Australia

Lively fruit flavours of passionfruit and citrus enhanced with a fresh natural acidity providing vibrancy and length on the finish.

Dusky Sounds

Marlborough, New Zealand

Open the bottle and you'll smell grapefruit and citrus with some herbaceous hints. The palate is bursting with the tropical zing we know and love from proper Kiwi Sauvignon Blanc and it ends with clean refreshing acids.

Taltarni Fumé

Pyrenees, Tasmania

White peach with herbal spice and delicate oak notes. A luscious front palate that extends into a mouth-filling grapefruit acid with a long clean finish. Passionfruit flavours softly dissipate into the melon and honeydew, this wine is a true representation of the fumé style.

South Australia

Bright lifted pear and green apple aromas with juicy, crisp and mouth-watering taste with ripe white fruit flavours and bright savoury finish.

Ara Single Estate

Marlborough, New Zealand

Delicate aromas of pear and nectarine which flow through to honeyed floral and citrus notes on the palate. This Pinot Gris/Grigio matches perfectly with the spice in dumplings and curries!

Tiefenbrunner DOC

Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy

An unobtrusive bouquet with hints of pear and candied fruit. In the glass, the wine has a harmonious structure emphasising its dry full-bodied taste and round finish.

Riesling

Wolf Blass Eaglehawk

South Australia

This lovely Riesling has a little sweetness to offset its naturally racy, citrus acidity. Its perfect food match is spice – try it with the dumplings with chilli sauce for lunch!

Leo Buring

Clare Valley, South Australia

Fresh lime combines with a delicate floral touch and some inviting spice. Great depth and fine acidity with aromas of stewed apple, citrus and blossom. This is a perfectly-balanced steely Riesling – if you like a Riesling, this is the wine for you!

Pewsey Vale

Eden Valley, South Australia

From the estate of Australia's oldest grapevines, this wine has great length and depth with limes, fresh rosemary, white pepper and a hint of tropical fruit. It finishes with a fresh natural acidity which balances the flavour intensity and a minerality not often seen in a new world wine.

Seppelt The Drives

Yarra Valley, Victoria

A full mouth-feel with sweet stone fruits and citrus peel, brought together with talc texture and fine, citrusy acid. Goes great with the chicken pie or any of the prawn dumplings

Mr Smith

Mornington Peninsula, Victoria

Tropical stone fruit and toasty oak on the nose, this wine has a creamy and buttery texture balanced with hints of citrus acidity slightly integrated with vanillin oak. The kind of wine that could be drunk for the whole night!

Petaluma White Label

Adelaide Hills, South Australia

This wine is bright, fruit forward, and has lovely citrus and stone fruits. The palate is dominated by grapefruit and melon, hints of white peach and is framed by crisp acidity and lovely subtle oak.

RED WINE

Pinot Noir

Waipara, South Island, New Zealand

Our cousins across the ditch have made this great little Pinot Noir with black cherries and plum aromas with savoury, oak highlights. A ripe, fleshy wine with a great palate weight with a well-integrated lingering aftertaste.

St Hubert's The Stag

Yarra Valley, Victoria

Juicy up front flavours with ripe plums giving way to a lovely savoury body and a perfectly balanced tannin backbone. For those who love their Pinot's this is the wine for you. Pair with Chicken or Vegetarian pie!

Pipers River, Tasmania

Red berry fruit aromas and freshly cut plums with a fine oak spice are balanced with savoury herbs. It benefits from breathing and you'll notice the difference from the start to end of the bottle.
